

Amagansett Library Unattended Children Policy

The Amagansett Free Library encourages children of all ages to visit the Library. Programs and resources are offered to make the Library a place that develops curiosity and stimulates learning for people of all ages.

The Library is not in loco parentis but seeks to have a reasoned response prepared when a problem presents itself. The happiness and safety of children left alone at the Library can be of serious concern. For the protection and well-being of children who visit our Library, children ten and over are welcome to visit unattended but should have a way to contact a caregiver in case a problem arises. Children under ten should visit with a caregiver over the age of twelve.
