The Amagansett Free Library had an exciting year! The Board of Directors and Staff have worked hard to sustain our vision of the Amagansett Free Library as a wellspring of educational enrichment and as the cultural hub of our hamlet.

A few highlights from the 2021-2022 year:

- The library is currently open for our Winter hours: Monday-Saturday 10:00 am - 5:00 pm & Sunday 1:00 pm - 4:00 pm.
- Our website, amagansettlibrary.org, is a great place to view upcoming online events, access research databases, browse and request items, and download or stream e-books, e-audiobooks, and movies.
- We have new tables and chairs for the library's lawn for year-round use, with more coming in 2022!
- Children's book circulation went up 18.48%, and electronic materials circulation jumped 39.57%.
- The library had its roof repaired in early 2022.
