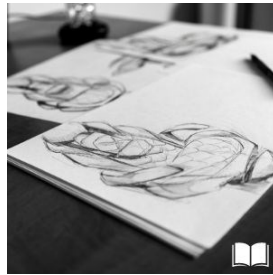

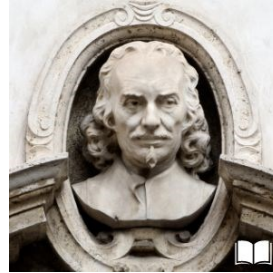

Get into the Fall season spirit by creating your own pumpkin painting with fall flowers with acrylic paint on canvas.



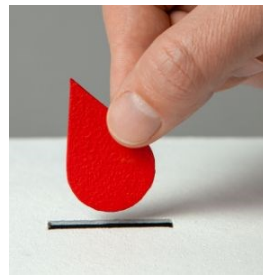
### Breast Cancer Awareness
